

Acrylic Painting materials list

Please feel free to use the materials that you enjoy, but the three primary colors are best in the recommended brands! You may wish to bring a painting shirt, smock, or wear old painting clothes! Plastic Gloves are also helpful.

1. One #2 office pencil and an eraser
2. Spray bottle
3. One stainless steel or plastic palette knife
4. Acrylic Brushes - worn watercolor brushes work well
 - a. 2 inch Foam Brush
 - b. White Taklon Synthetic brushes: #6 Round, #8 Bright, #12 Filbert
 - c. Loew Cornell 1170 All Purpose Brush Set Nylon 1, 2, and 3 inch
5. Painting surfaces and supports:
 - a. Canson XL Mixed Media Sketchbook 9 x 12 98lb. paper
 - b. Stretched Acrylic Primed Canvases - several of the same size! Michaels is best to purchase a pack
6. Acrylic Medium: Liquitex Slow-Dri Blending Medium - Liquid or Gel
7. White Acrylic Gesso (Liquitex in a bottle is a great choice)
8. Basic Artist Quality Palette with the below colors
 - a. Hansa Yellow Medium or Benzimidazalone Yellow Medium
 - b. Quinacridone Crimson or Quinacridone Magenta
 - c. Cobalt Blue or Maganese Blue
 - d. Burnt Sienna
 - e. Mars Black
 - f. Titanium White

OR

Basic Student Grade Acrylic Paint Blick Studio Brand Acrylic Paint in the following colors:

- a. Primary Yellow
 - b. Cadmium Orange Hue
 - c. Quinacridone Magenta
 - d. Cerulean Blue hue
 - e. Paynes Gray
 - f. White
9. Semi-gloss or regular gel medium in a jar
10. Matt medium in a bottle
11. 3 small bottles of Golden Fluid Acrylics
 - a. Hansa Yellow Medium
 - b. Quinacridone Magenta
 - c. Maganese Blue
12. Soft Brayer Roller
13. One jar of light molding paste
16. Disposable palette paper pad, 9 x 12 or similar
