- **Weekly Themes:** Develop, plan and implement Jewish-themed weekly educational programming that aligns with the camp's mission and values.
- **Head of Israeli Education and Culture:** Work together with our Israeli Culture Specialist to provide a program that introduces and celebrates Israeli culture and education, including language (basic Hebrew phrases), Israeli games, food, traditions, and special events to immerse campers in Israeli heritage.
- **Shabbat Celebration:** Create, plan, and execute a weekly camp wide Shabbat celebration. Collaborate with staff to ensure a joyful and inclusive Shabbat experience for all campers, regardless of their level of observance.
- **Music & Dance:** Work with song leaders and dance instructors to bring Jewish music and dancing into the camp's daily life.
- Programming & Events: Work closely with the camp leadership and other program
  coordinators to ensure that Jewish culture and education is seamlessly incorporated into camp
  wide events, traditions, and special activities.
- Evaluate the season and share suggestions for the following season.

- Strong background in Jewish education and passion for Jewish culture, traditions, and values.
- Experience working in a camp setting or with children in a similar environment.
- Excellent organizational and leadership skills.
