Painting with Watercolor & Watercolor Pencil

Materials List

Please feel free to use the materials you most enjoy, this list only serves as a guide.

1. Derwent Watercolor Pencils (They can be purchased separately and should have a small paint brush icon on the handle):

a. sky blue 34b. spectrum blue 32c. magenta 22

d. burnt carmine 65

e. deep cadmium 6f. chinese white 72g. ivory black 67

(You may also wish to purchase a set of water-soluble watercolor pencils - any size that you feel comfortable with, but a set of 24 pencils or larger is best. My favorite brand is Rexel Derwent Water-Soluble Colored Pencils. Make sure that the colors listed above are included in your set!)

2. 1 tube of white Gouache - any brand

- 3. One #2 office pencil and one sandpaper lead pointer (small sheets of extra-fine sandpaper stapled to a small wooden paddle, used for honing pencil points)
- 4. One Straedler Plastic eraser and one kneaded eraser
- 5. One sheet of 140 lb. hot-press Watercolor Paper: D'Arches, Fabriano or Lanaquarelle brand Watercolor Paper and one sheet of cold-pressed 140 lb. Watercolor Paper
- 6. Watercolor brushes (Synthetic or comparable. Make sure the rounds come to a good point.)
 - **a.** #10 Kingart original gold Max Round or #10 Princeton Velvet Touch Mixed Media Ultra Round (Ulta Round by Loew Cornell is no longer available)
 - b. 1 inch Flat, 7100 La Corneille
 - c. 1/2 inch Flat, W&N, Series 975 or similar
- 7. Canson XL Mixed Media Sketchbook 9 x 12 98lb paper
- 8. 3M drafting tape, 1 inch or ½ inch
- 9. Pencil sharpener of your choice battery operated or hand held
- 10. Two permanent, dark colored, fine point markers. Pitt and Micron are good brands. I would stay away from Sharpie unless it is the non-bleed through pen. Please choose the point size and the two dark colors you prefer.
- 11. Basic Six Artist Quality Tube Colors

a. Aureolin Yellow

d. Cobalt Turquoise Light

b. Permanent Rose

e. Burnt Sienna

c. Cobalt Blue

f. Indigo
