How do I choose the right instrument for my child?

To choose an instrument, start by considering your child’s interests, personality, and physical capacity. Before committing to a specific instrument, expose them to different types of instruments, listen to music in every way possible, and attend concerts. Age and size are also important factors, as some instruments require more physical strength, lung capacity, dexterity, coordination or hand size than others.

When should my child start?

The chart below is a guide to when a child can begin to learn an instrument.

Instrument	Age to Start
Violin, Cello, Flute	3+
Guitar, Piano, Percussion (including drum set)	4+
Harp, Recorder, Viola	5+
Ukulele, Voice (Choir)	6+
Clarinet	7+
Oboe, Saxophone, Trumpet, Double Bass, French Horn, Bassoon (depending on size of student)	8+
Baritone Horn, Trombone, Tuba, Euphonium	10+
Voice	11+

** Tuition for strings, wind, brass, and voice lessons include accompanist for student recitals including recital preparation.

INSTRUMENTAL GROUP CLASSES

Group classes are essential components that build on and complement the learning that takes place in private lessons, foster a collaborative approach and include performance opportunities.

To join our instrumental group classes, students must be taking private lessons concurrently at Thurnauer or outside Thurnauer. Placement evaluations are required for new students.

All ages indicated are recommended for each instrumental group but have flexibility. Group classes may not be taken on their own as introductory classes.

We offer rolling enrollment throughout the year for all our group classes. Tuition is pro-rated based on start date.

MUSICIANSHIP AND COMPOSITION



Students develop musical literacy through theory, ear training, sight-singing, and composition, and gain a deeper understanding of how music is put together - knowledge that supports their instrumental or vocal studies and builds confidence as musicians.

MUSICIANSHIP: THEORY AND EAR TRAINING

8+ Years

Students learn about hearing the sounds of written music before they are played (sight singing), translating heard sounds into notation (ear-training), and making creative decisions on how to choose and combine sounds (composition) to build a complete musical fluency. Various class levels offered. Small group instruction.

MUSICIANSHIP FOR GUITARISTS

12+ Years, Including Adults | [Online](#)

This class bridges the gap between music theory, ear training, sight-singing and composition and what you play on the guitar. Students learn how the building blocks of sound (intervals, scales, and chords) are organized into patterns and shapes on the fretboard.

AP MUSIC THEORY PREP

15+ Years

This course is a thorough study of musical elements that are on the AP Music Theory exam and includes in-depth ear training and weekly assignments, culminating in a practice exam review.

COMPOSITION 1

Designed to give young musicians the knowledge and confidence to craft original compositions for one-to-multiple instruments. Students explore what makes music “work” through analysis and hands-on activities and develop their own creative ideas.

13+ Years

Students learn how to create melodies and accompaniments spontaneously on their primary instrument. This class focuses on learning music by ear, with hands-on activities.

REGISTRATION

NEW FAMILIES ENROLLING IN PRIVATE LESSONS, INSTRUMENTAL GROUPS OR ENSEMBLES

All students new to the school must meet with the Artistic Director prior to enrollment. Once we have met, you will receive instructions for creating your account, enrolling in your programs, and setting up a payment plan.

FAMILIES ENROLLING ONLY IN EARLY CHILDHOOD, INTRODUCTORY INSTRUMENTAL CLASSES OR ADULT PROGRAMS

You can enroll directly on the Kaplen JCC website.

- If you already have an account with the JCC, log in and complete the enrollment step by step.
- If you do not have an account, click on Create Account, and add the information for the student taking the class. If you will be enrolling more than one child, or if your child will be taking more than one class, please contact the music school staff, so we can help you enroll while receiving the appropriate discounts.

DEPOSIT AND REGISTRATION FEES

Each student taking a private lesson program must pay a \$75 registration fee.

Tuition is pro-rated if you start mid-year. Classes or ensembles taken without private lessons is the first month's payment (approximately 1/10 of the total tuition for 30-week classes or 1/5 for 15 weeks).
